The Head of Market Risk Oversight (MRO) is a Senior Vice President/Vice President position reporting directly to the Chief Risk Officer. This individual is responsible for providing effective oversight of the measurement and management of the market risks that Fannie Mae faces, namely the interest rate risk, liquidity risk and foreign currency risk inherent in the portfolio.

The main responsibilities of this position are:

- Developing the market risk management framework that defines the metrics used for reporting and monitoring, setting the thresholds and determining the escalation process in case of limit excesses in order to ensure adherence to the risk tolerance level set by the Board.
- Developing and maintenance of corporate-level market risk policies that codify the market risk management framework.
- Overseeing the risk measurement and management processes to ensure compliance with policy and framework.
- Providing executive management and the Board with independent perspective on the adequacy of the management and measurement of market risk.
- Providing the enterprise's thought leadership on market risk issues and relevant industry, regulatory and legal developments.
